Project Reperio

Project Reperio started in 2020, amid the Covid-19 pandemic, when overseas community projects were put on hold. Striving to serve beyond our borders, several ACS (Independent) students partnered with the Non-Governmental Organisation (NGO), Cahaya Surya Bakti, to provide online tutoring to Rohingya refugees in Johor, Malaysia.

Our volunteers don't just engage the Rohingya students through English language enrichment programmes. They also provide targeted tutoring to help these students excel in their IGCSE subjects. This internationally recognized qualification opens doors for them to pursue higher education abroad or secure placements at universities in the Philippines.

In addition to academic support, our volunteers equip Rohingya students with valuable nonacademic skills ranging from video editing to financial literacy. This fosters holistic student development, preparing them for a future that demands a diverse skillset.

Now in its fourth year, Project Reperio remains dedicated to empowering the Rohingya children through education.
